Reasoning and problem solving are fundamental to knowing and doing mathematics and yet it is often this area that learners find difficult and the area that is often considered difficult to teach.

- discuss the importance of the 5 proficiencies and how these need to be central to the development of the mathematics curriculum
- explore approaches that ensure learners can solve problems confidently, tackle non-standard problems, apply their mathematical skills and explain their thinking
- identify the specific skills that learners need and discuss why these skills are so important to understanding mathematics.

### 'What does Donaldson Look Like in KS2?'

In his 'Successful Futures' Report the ethos, principles and pedagogy of the current Foundation Phase was identified as a significant strength of current educational practice in Wales. It was recommended that schools build on successful 'Foundation' practice, philosophy and pedagogy into the middle and later years of primary education and beyond. How this works in practice needs to be carefully managed to ensure that transition issues are removed and progression is ensured.

*This course will include:*

- what exactly are we supposed to be Building on?
- what does a successful Foundation Phase look like?
- what are the key words of successful practice and excellence?
- how do we take some of these elements of the Foundation Phase into KS2?

*The KS2 Classroom:*

- what will they look like in practice?
- what refinements need to be made?
- what curriculum 'areas' do we need to put into these classrooms?
- how do we promote independent learning here?
- how do we take the aspects of a successful Foundation Phase into these classrooms and yet ensure progression?
